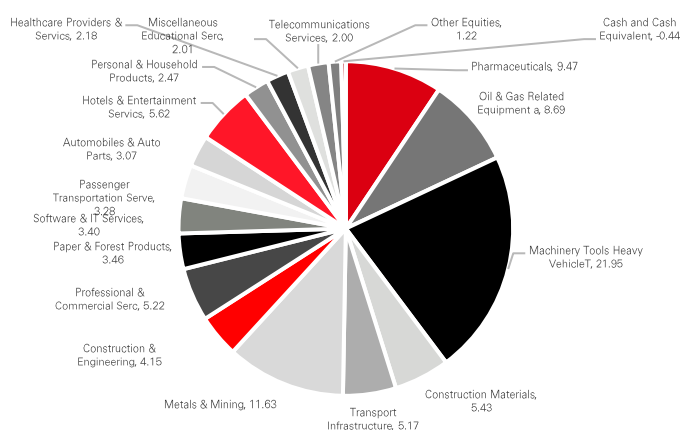

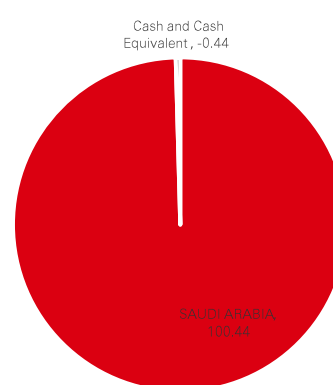

Sector Allocation (%)⁽⁴⁾

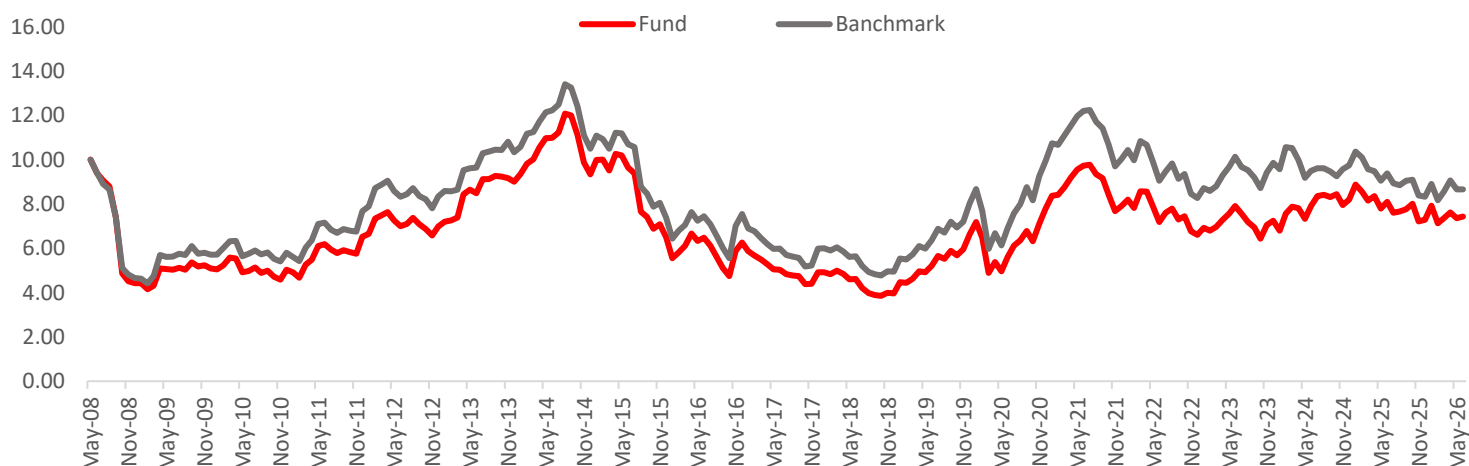


Geographical Allocation (%)⁽⁴⁾
