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INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REVIEW REPORT ON THE INTERIM CONDENSED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS TO THE UNITHOLDERS OF SAB INVEST SAUDI CONSTRUCTION & CEMENT COMPANIES EQUITY FUND (MANAGED BY SAB INVEST)

Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying interim condensed statement of financial position of SAB Invest Saudi Construction & Cement Companies Equity Fund (the "Fund") managed by SAB Invest (the "Fund Manager") as at 30 June 2026, and the related interim condensed statement of comprehensive income for the six-month period ended 30 June 2026, and the related interim condensed statement of changes in net assets attributable to the unitholders and cash flows for the six-month period then ended, and explanatory notes. The Fund Manager is responsible for the preparation and presentation of these interim condensed financial statements in accordance with International Accounting Standard 34, "Interim Financial Reporting" ("IAS 34") as endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on these interim condensed financial statements based on our review.

Scope of Review

We conducted our review in accordance with International Standard on Review Engagements 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity" as endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. A review of interim financial statements consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with International Standards on Auditing that are endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Conclusion

Based on our review, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying interim condensed financial statements are not prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with IAS 34 as endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

1 CORPORATE INFORMATION AND PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES

SAB Invest Saudi Construction & Cement Companies Equity Fund (the “Fund”) is an investment fund created by an agreement between SAB Invest (the “Fund Manager”) and investors (the “Unitholders”) in the Fund. The address of the Fund Manager is as follows:

The objective of the Fund is to achieve long term capital appreciation, through investing in Shariah-compliant construction and cement Saudi equities.

SAB Invest Operations were appointed as an Operator - Administrator of the fund in which an Asset Management Operation (AMO) has appointed a Sub-admin.

The Fund is managed by the Fund Manager who also acts as the administrator of the Fund. Albilad Capital is the custodian of the Fund. All income is reinvested in the Fund and is reflected in the unit price.

2 REGULATING AUTHORITY

The Fund is governed by the Investment Funds Regulations (the “Regulations”), issued by the Board of the Capital Market Authority (CMA) pursuant to Resolution No. 1-219-2006 dated 3 Dhul Hijjah 1427H (corresponding to 24 December 2006G), based on the Capital Market Law issued by Royal Decree No. M/30 dated 2 Jumada Al-Thani 1424H, and as amended by Resolution of the Board of the CMA No. 1-54-2025 dated 23 Dhul-Qi’dah 1446H (corresponding to 21 May 2025G), detailing requirements for investment funds within the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

3 BASIS OF PREPARATION AND MATERIAL ACCOUNTING POLICY INFORMATION

3.1 Statement of compliance

These unaudited interim condensed financial statements for the six-month period ended 30 June 2026 have been prepared in accordance with International Accounting Standard 34 “Interim Financial Reporting” (“IAS 34”) as endorsed in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

3.2 Basis of preparation

The unaudited interim condensed financial statements do not include all the information and disclosures required in the annual financial statements and should be read in conjunction with the Fund’s annual financial statements as at 31 December 2025. In addition, results for the six-month period ended 30 June 2026 are not necessarily indicative of the results that may be expected for the financial year ending 31 December 2026.

The accounting policies adopted in the preparation of these unaudited interim condensed financial statements are consistent with those followed in the preparation of the Fund’s annual financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2025.

The unaudited interim condensed financial statements have been prepared on a historical cost basis, using the accrual basis of accounting except for financial assets held at FVTPL that are measured at fair value. These unaudited interim condensed financial statements are presented in Saudi Arabian Riyals (“**ﷲ**”) which is the Fund’s functional currency. All financial information presented has been rounded to the nearest **ﷲ**.

The Fund pays the Fund Manager a management fee calculated at an annual rate of 1.70% per annum, and administrator fee up to 0.10% calculated on the net asset value at each valuation date.

There are 6,932 units in issue at 30 June 2026 held by the employees of the Fund Manager (31 December 2025: 8,027 units)

6 FAIR VALUE OF FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS

The Fund has only investments at fair value through profit or loss which is measured at fair values and are classified within level 1 of the fair value hierarchy. All other financial assets and liabilities are classified as amortized cost and management believes that the fair value of all other financial assets and liabilities at the reporting date approximate their carrying values owing to their short-term tenure and the fact that these are readily liquid. There were no transfers between various levels of fair value hierarchy during the current period or prior year.

8 SUBSEQUENT EVENTS

There have been no significant subsequent events since the period ended 30 June 2026 that require disclosure or adjustment in these interim condensed financial statements.

However, the geopolitical situation in the Middle East has deteriorated significantly since 28 February 2026. The situation has remained highly volatile and has impacted several countries in the Middle East including Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, causing disruption to some business and economic activities.

The Fund Manager is closely monitoring the situation and has activated its business continuity planning and other risk management practices to manage the potential business disruption on its operations and financial performance due to the geopolitical outbreak.

The Fund Manager has assessed the potential implications of the changes in geopolitical situations on its operations, financial position and performance. Based on information currently available, including the continuation of core business activities, it is not practicable to reliably estimate the full financial effect of the changes in geopolitical situations on the future periods. The Fund Manager has also considered the impact of these situations on the Fund's ability to continue as a going concern and has concluded that the going concern basis of preparation remains appropriate.

9 LAST VALUATION DAY

The last valuation day of the period / year was 30 June 2026 (2025: 31 December 2025).

10 APPROVAL OF THE INTERIM CONDENSED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

These unaudited interim condensed financial statements of the fund for the six-month period ended 30 June 2026 were approved by the Fund Manager's Board of Directors on 10 August 2026 (corresponding to 27 Safar 1448H).
